If a service must be conducted on a Sunday or holiday or at any other time outside the normal tour of duty of the employee, then reimbursable overtime must be paid for each service, in addition to the user fee listed in this section.

There is a maximum charge of 12 times the hourly rate in 9 CFR § 130.3.
